

Holy Communion

“For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took a loaf of bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, ‘This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.’ In the same way he took the cup also, after supper, saying, ‘This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.’ For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.” (1 Corinthians 11:23-26)

In Bethlehem, Holy Communion is celebrated on the second Sunday of each month during morning worship service. All believers in right standing with God are invited to the Lord’s Table. The Pastor, Ministerial Staff and Deacons administer Holy Communion, and the Deaconess prepare the table. Any members who desire communion to be served in private should make their requests known to the Pastor or the Deacon Ministry.
